Dear PracticeMaster / CompuLaw user:

We are writing you to give you notification that, effective December 1, 2009 the courts have made some major changes to the way state and federal holidays are handled in federal courts. These changes have necessitated some major modifications to the functionality of our court rules engine software and court rules databases. The new engine and databases now utilize Microsoft SQL and SQL Express. Please note that if you do not currently run SQL Server in your office, you will still be able to use the new software, as we will include download instructions for SQL Express with the software.

Software Technology, Inc. (STI) has been working with CompuLaw to ensure that PracticeMaster supports the changes and to provide you with a seamless transition to the new CompuLaw software and rules databases. Sometime before December 1, 2009, the CompuLaw and PracticeMaster (version 15.3) updates will be available as a download from the CompuLaw and STI websites. You will receive further notification when these updates are available.

Installation of the new software will be simple and the conversion of your rules from Btrieve to SQL format will be automatic. It is important that you install and implement the new software before December 1, 2009, because as of that date, CompuLaw rules updates will be compatible only with the new rules engine, which in turn will be compatible only with version 15.3 of PracticeMaster.

Again, we wish to thank you for continuing to support the CompuLaw and STI partnership. Please know that we do not take the trust that you place with us for granted. Your business and continued loyalty is important to us and greatly appreciated.
